

**AMENDED PROCLAMATION DECLARING STATE OF EMERGENCY  
THROUGHOUT THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF  
MANGUM, OKLAHOMA**

WHEREAS, on March 11, 2020, the World Health Organization (WHO) has declared COVID-19 (Coronavirus) to be a global pandemic; and,

WHEREAS, on March 13, 2020, the President of the United States of America has declared an infectious disease National Emergency Declaration to combat COVID-19; and,

WHEREAS, on March 15, 2020 the Governor of the State of Oklahoma has declared a State of Emergency for all 77 counties in Oklahoma; and

WHEREAS, on March 23, 2020 the County Commissioners of Greer County has declared a State of Emergency for all of Greer County, Oklahoma; and

WHEREAS, on March 31, 2020 the Oklahoma Department of Health has confirmed cases of COVID-19 within Greer County; and, (Added March 31, 2020)

WHEREAS, health professional and researchers have determined COVID-19 is spread by human contact and interaction; and,

WHEREAS, practicing methods such as social distancing is believed to slow the spread of COVID-19; and,

WHEREAS, the spread of COVID-19 is a disaster affecting life, health, and safety of city residents and non-residents alike; and,

WHEREAS, the aforementioned conditions constitute a threat to the safety and welfare of the City of Mangum and create an emergency situation within the meaning of Section 683.3, Oklahoma Emergency Act of 2003, as amended.

NOW, THEREFORE, BY VIRTUE OF THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME BY STATE LAW, I, MARY JANE SCOTT, MAYOR OF THE CITY OF MANGUM, OKLAHOMA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM AND DECLARE THAT A STATE OF EMERGENCY NOW EXISTS THROUGHOUT THE CITY OF MANGUM, OKLAHOMA; and,

IT IS FURTHER DECLARED AND ORDERED that during the State of Emergency, the Mayor, City Board of Commissioners, and the City Manager shall exercise those powers, functions, and duties prescribed by Oklahoma law, the City of Mangum Charter,

and all applicable ordinances, resolutions and the Greer County Emergency Operations Plan in order to minimize the effects of said emergency; and,

IT IS FURTHER DECLARED AND ORDERED that effective immediately, all previously scheduled special events authorized by the City of Mangum during this State of Emergency are hereby canceled or postponed, and all events with 10 or more participants at City owned/operated facilities are hereby suspended; and,

IT IS FURTHER DECLARED AND ORDERED that effective immediately, the City Manager is directed to not discontinue water and utility services for customers unable to pay their bills as long as the state of emergency exists; and,

IT IS FURTHER DECLARED AND ORDERED that effective immediately, all child-care facilities, hospitals, clinics, or long-term care facilities are prohibited from allowing visitation of such facilities as long as the state of emergency exists; and, (Amended March 31, 2020)

IT IS FURTHER DECLARED AND ORDERED that effective 12:01 AM, March 24th, 2020 through the termination of the declared emergency, all restaurants, bars, or any business with on-premises food service are restricted to take-out or delivery of food and sale of prepackaged alcohol authorized for sale under state law. Such locations are otherwise closed to the public and persons, other than employees, are restricted from such places for any other purpose. This provision does not include institutional or in-house cafeterias serving residents, employees, child-care facilities, hospitals or long-term care facilities; and,

~~IT IS FURTHER DECLARED AND ORDERED that effective 12:01 AM, March 24th, 2020 through the termination of the declared emergency, the following places are closed to the public to all persons except personnel necessary for the maintenance of the facility and grounds, are restricted from such places: (replaced by amended order, March 31, 2020)~~

- ~~1. Athletic gyms, exercise facilities, indoor sports facilities, and similar recreation facilities.~~
- ~~2. Community centers.~~
- ~~3. Outdoor event venues.~~

IT IS FURTHER DECLARED AND ORDERED that all residents of Mangum and medical providers in Mangum shall postpone all elective surgeries, minor medical procedures, and non-emergency dental procedures until April 16, 2020. (Added March 31, 2020)

IT IS FURTHER DECLARED AND ORDERED that effective 11:59 PM, March 31<sup>st</sup>, 2020 through April 16<sup>th</sup>, 2020, all citizens of the City of Mangum are required to shelter in place at their place of residence. (Added March 31, 2020)

Citizens are only allowed to leave their residences for essential activities or operate essential businesses.

For purposes of this declaration, "essential activities" include:

- To engage in activities or perform tasks essential to their health and safety, or to the health and safety of their family, household members, or pets (for example, obtaining medical supplies or medication, visiting a health care professional, obtaining supplies needed to work from home, or perform property maintenance)
- To obtain necessary services or supplies for themselves, family, household members, or pets or to deliver those services or supplies to others (for example, food and beverage, pet supply, and any other household consumer products, and products necessary to maintain the safety, sanitation, and essential operation of residences)
- To engage in outdoor activity, provided the individuals, except household members, follow social distancing guidelines issued by the CDC (for example, walking, biking, hiking, or running)
- To perform work at an Essential Business
- To care for or transport a family member or pet in another household
- To move to another residence either in or outside the limits of the City of Mangum
- To otherwise carry out activities specifically permitted in this Declaration

"Essential businesses" mean those businesses identified by the Governor of the State of Oklahoma, or his designee, as critical infrastructure sectors by the Governor's March 24th Executive Order.

IT IS FURTHER DECLARED AND ORDERED that effective 11:59 pm, March 31, 2020 through April 16, 2020, that all City-owned or operated sports courts, basketball courts, sports fields, fitness courts, and playgrounds are closed to the public and all persons except personnel necessary for maintenance of the facility and grounds. (Added March 31, 2020)

IT IS FURTHER DECLARED AND ORDERED that effective 11:59 pm, March 31, 2020 through April 16, 2020, all businesses operating within the limits of the City of Mangum, Oklahoma, except Essential Businesses, identified by the Governor of the State of Oklahoma, are required to close all facilities located within the City and all

persons, with exceptions provide below, are restricted from such places. (Added March 31, 2020)

- Provided that any business may continue to perform essential functions with employees or contractors as necessary to maintain the value of the business' inventory, preserve the condition of the business' physical plant and equipment, ensure security, process payroll and employee benefits and related functions.
- For clarity, non-essential businesses may continue operations consisting exclusively of employees or contractors performing activities remotely (i.e. working from home).
- For Essential Businesses continuing to operate, to the extent possible all businesses shall practice social distancing which may include but is not limited to maintaining six (6) feet between both employees and the general public, off-setting shifts and/or days, and requiring employees to conduct work remotely.

IT IS FURTHER DECLARED AND ORDERED that any business owner keeping a non-essential business open in violation of this Declaration shall be subject the applicable provisions of the Mangum Municipal Code. (Added March 31, 2020)

IT IS FURTHER DECLARED AND ORDERED that all Mangum citizens should take extra measures to put distance between yourself and other people to further reduce your risk of being exposed to this virus, and should avail themselves of the resources and information through the Greer County Health Department, the Oklahoma State Department of Health, and the Center for Disease Control (CDC).


